Key Skills for Children

1. **Empathy & Love.** We treat others how we want to be treated. We engage with local and national issues and initiatives such as the climate, homelessness and our local farming community. We understand that everybody is different and everybody is of equal value.
2. **Resilient & Determined.** We are independent and never give up. We know what to do if we struggle with something. We want to be the best person we can be.
3. **Inquisitive & knowledgeable.** We love learning and love to share what we have learned/our interests with others. Our children have the knowledge (local and global) and cultural capital necessary to succeed in 21st Century Britain.
4. **Responsible & Confident.** Our children love working together. Older children take care of younger children and we provide opportunities for all children to work together. Our children speak in public at half-termly church services and performances.
5. **Healthy & Active.** Our children know how to keep healthy and safe, physically and mentally. They spend time learning and playing outdoors. They have the opportunity to run with staff twice per week and to represent our school at sporting events.
6. **Spiritual & Appreciative** of the beauty of animals and nature. Our children can identify at least 3 flowers and 3 trees and understand how animals enrich our lives and know how to care for them. They experience the liturgical structure of a church service, reflect on religious teaching and develop their own beliefs, whilst respecting the beliefs of others.
7. **Creative & Enterprising.** Our children use their imagination and are creative. They listen, sing, play instruments and compose. They problem-solve after careful thought and analysis. They have the opportunity to prepare child-led activities/initiatives to optimise school further.
8. **Understand the Importance of Reading.** All children can talk about books they enjoy and school will do everything to foster a love of reading in our children
9. **Technologically confident.** Our children are familiar with email and ICT applications. They understand the benefits of ICT, including mobile phones and social media, and know how to stay safe.
10. **Polite & Happy.** Our children are happy coming to school. They can identify when they do not feel happy and know how to manage these feelings and find support. Our children use their manners to show respect for everybody.
