- 1) My children always want to go to school  
My children experience a wide variety of extra curricular activities which are seamlessly woven into daily life – caring for a duckling, spontaneous walks round the countryside. Thank you  
Since moving to Mugginton 3 months ago he doesn't worry about going to school anymore.  
Safe, interested, cared for  
Our children tell us through their words and behavior – they are thriving socially, emotionally and academically  
They are eager to come, take part and learn  
My child comes home smiling and happy and full of stories of what they have done in the day  
My child is thriving both academically and in personal development  
My child is always happy going to school  
The school has a great atmosphere and core values which comes across strongly in my child  
It is a friendly and inviting place to learn  
She is socially and academically confident  
Despite just starting at Mugginton they are really happy
- 2) It is a wonderful, nurturing and caring environment  
Everyone is kind and welcoming. There is an open door policy with staff  
My child is cautious and likes how calm and happy the school is which makes him feel safe  
It is a safe, happy environment where everyone is friendly and caring  
All teachers are vigilant for any risks to the children and would take appropriate action to mitigate the situation. I have not had a cause for concern in 4 years  
They are nurtured emotionally and trust the adults in school  
It is clear that care is taken around security & Wellbeing  
She know she can tell a school grown up if she has any problems  
She understands Internet Safety and trusts the care of staff and leaders  
I have a slight concern with the growing numbers
- 3) Their academic ability improves. In particular Year 2 has come on leaps and bounds  
This year has been great  
Absolutely! All children have made excellent progress  
The school is very good at working with parents to help the child progress  
He is so much happier. He is made to feel special and given time and support  
His results demonstrate his amazing achievement

Mrs Wallen & Mr Clarke are amazing teachers – the children talk about them all the time!

Teachers are fantastic

We are always updated when our child has done well (or not so well!) and where improvement can be made

Although they've just started we've already seen progression in reading levels, and just enjoying school again is progress

A lot of work has been put into help my child catch up

- 4) Staff know our children so well and this means they are able to offer appropriate support, care and guidance. They are able to pre-empt situations they might find challenging. All staff are approachable

The curriculum is varied and challenging – a wide range of approaches are used and lessons taught by highly skilled, motivated and dedicated staff. Assessment is thorough

The school makes learning fun and covers a wide degree of topics. The teachers are excellent

My child has enjoyed the Superhero Maths challenges. He is engaged and excited about his learning

We particularly agree with the regular use of the outdoors and the amount of time given to exercise and sports

He loves the teachers because they help explain things well and in a way that he can understand

Superb teachers who genuinely care about the children

Provide additional support for pupils who are not confident using numbers

A little more challenge, maybe

- 6) My child has extra homework that stretches him

Our children enjoy the homework they are set

I trust the school to give them what they feel is appropriate

Maybe split homework to Y3/4 & Y5/6

He is able to work independently and we don't feel overloaded

My child finds it quite easy

Happy with the required homework

Some work has been too difficult for her to complete without full support

- 7) Behaviour is exemplary

The school has a calm, settled atmosphere. He says the teachers never shout

I hear teachers acting appropriately if children are misbehaving and taking control of the situation.

My children are aware of what to do if their peers misbehave

No issues ever brought home

Pupils at the school are always polite and helpful

Absolutely agree, clear expectation of good behavior and respect for others  
Always have good manners and encouraged to play nicely together  
The children are incredibly well behaved and polite to each other and adults  
The teachers are good at clearly setting boundaries for children to work within  
Things can be missed on the playground  
Children sometimes get Dojos in a random way  
Reminding older children that they are setting an example to the younger ones

- 8) I asked the children and they felt it would be, which is what counts for me  
The school openly does not tolerate such behavior. The children are taught tolerance, acceptance kindness and respect  
The children are taught to care for and respect each other  
We have never experienced bullying at school which is a testament to the children's behaviour  
We believe part of the school's ethos is there is no room for bullying and everyone is accepted. My children have been welcomed by everyone and made friends very easily  
There is a policy in place. Any concerns regarding behavior between pupils is taken seriously  
Prepare the children for what may be ahead of them at secondary school.  
Any incidents are dealt with quickly and with sensitivity to all concerned  
The small school has a lovely family feel and any pupil-pupil disagreements are dealt with quickly and effectively  
I trust they would  
Be a bit more proactive when issues are raised  
Could have better follow up after accidents
- 9) There is a clear structure to the school staff and all seem happy to do their best in their roles  
Mr Green has a real vision for which he works very hard and with dedication. The governing body is committed to the school  
Absolutely – great energy and effort is shown by Mr Green, which continues through all staff  
Everything runs smoothly and all staff seem happy

- 10) Any concerns I have ever had have been dealt with in a timely fashion...they have been acknowledged and plans put in place to remedy  
Not that we have any issues but any concerns are always listened to and great advice and support is given  
Prompt replies and calls when I needed support  
There is definitely an open door policy and everyone is very approachable  
Very rarely have we needed to raise concerns but when we have they have been taken seriously and acted upon

We have always been listened to, heard and welcomed to share our thoughts. Any responses needed has been immediate, appropriate and thoughtful  
Yes, but a little more proactive follow-up would be really helpful

- 11) Parents Evening feedback has been thorough and we thought the interim assessment sheet we received was super  
Lots of verbal communication – ongoing which is very valuable  
Always willing to talk to me  
A Parent App would improve this  
The open door policy means at any time we will be able to ask how our children are progressing and already teachers have been giving us feedback  
Regular informal feedback from the teachers, more formally through parents evenings
- 12) Just this week I have done so! I couldn't ask for anything more for my children's primary school I just have!  
I always tell everyone to come!  
We feel very fortunate our children are having the Mugginton experience! Every aspect of our children and their development is nurtured  
The school was recommended to us and we are so grateful  
Yes, although I don't want it to grow too much!!  
We think Mugginton is a really unique school that nurtures its pupils and provides a really happy and fun learning environment where each individual is encouraged to do their best and grow in confidence

- 13) I love how the children are allowed to be creative and spend time outdoors  
Yes, I believe it does  
Our children experience a wide ranging curriculum based on meaningful learning experiences and lessons. This is always summed up in end of term services. We would love to see language learning introduced if at all possible  
Yes! Core subjects are taught alongside a more holistic teaching  
Languages? Arts/acting etc could do more of  
Offer a language or two  
Strongly agree would again be better space to experience the curriculum
- 14) I don't know of any other local schools that have the same activities, school trips and extra curricular activities as Mugginton  
As well as strong academic learning experiences, they have the opportunity of Forest Fridays, sports, school trips, public speaking in church, drama in plays and music and singing  
My child often helps with cooking and gardening at Early Birds and this is before lessons start!  
The daily walks, runs and forest Friday help to provide a range of learning environments  
Lots of trips out  
All children have been able to take up musical instruments  
A real strength. Focus on outdoors/nature/sport is exceptional

- 15) My Year 2 has been greatly encouraged to read this year. School often listen to her read  
Much of my child's progress can be attributed to the amount of reading that the school encourages and facilitates  
Books always changed on time  
We struggle with reading at home but Mr Green is very supportive and encourages him  
My child has benefitted greatly from the studying of age-appropriate novels  
Kids are so enthusiastic about the books they read at school  
Since moving to Mugginton my children love to read whenever they can and really enthuse about the books they cover at school
- 16) Without a doubt! Since being at Mugginton our daughter has developed self-confidence and emotional resilience – she has been appreciated, nurtured and blossomed, by being with staff who accept and like her just as she is  
Lots of different experiences working with different age groups. Plenty of encouragement  
My children are confident. They try to solve problems they encounter and don't give up  
My child is constantly talking about when he is praised and given positive feedback  
I'm a firm believer in encouraging sports and outdoor activities...my child has really gained confidence as a result  
He is such a confident happy little boy now since we have moved schools  
I was surprised how quickly my children felt able and confident to stand up and talk in church services  
Yes. All children are encouraged to participate in end of term services with acting, speaking or singing  
Yes, did a presentation on dinosaurs on his first day!  
I have seen the children encouraged and the emphasis on sport helps to promote resilience – sometimes you win, sometimes you don't  
The children take responsibility for themselves and those younger in the school  
Pride in their school, achievements acknowledged  
I would be interested to hear more about how this is achieved
- 17) This is so important to everyone's Wellbeing  
I am more than happy – I'm borderline ecstatic  
Yes, this is something we value as a family  
We love this about Mugginton. The children are learning invaluable life skills  
Yes, and they miss Timmy!  
Yes! I love that we can go on walks and take all the dogs!  
Forest school in particular is a brilliant learning tool in the outdoors  
This has been a great move by the school to incorporate this aspect of learning  
Sports/outdoor learning encourages healthy minds and bodies  
Running and Forest Friday in nearly all weathers!  
Being outdoors and active can only enhance a child's learning experience
- 18) The support is tailored to the each child's needs  
KS2 – the marking & assessment systems really promote individual progress  
I am aware that my child is given work at a level which is stimulating and challenging to him. My Year 2 has improved so much this year and I think will continue to flourish when she moves to the

juniors.

They know every child individually therefore can tailor to their needs

He is doing exceptionally well now and he will be flying by the end of Year 6. We cannot thank the school/teachers enough

Yes, I know if I ask a teacher for support/guidance I would get it

Our KS1 child has already been given a harder reading level to try!

EYFS – targeted support, individual attention

He is given stretch activities when appropriate and continually encouraged

The children are always challenged in a variety of ways – number club etc

I think she could be challenged more to reach her potential, but she is happy!

We believe so but we don't get any information which confirms this

My children love attending Mugginton school and adore the teaching staff. I can't imagine that a better setting is out there for them. We are so very appreciative of the nurture, care and education you provide...you are all spoken of often at home – you feel like their extended family
