Apologies for another late email. I am sure you have heard the news that schools will be closed to most children until February half term.

I received this news at the same time you did and our immediate concern is having good-quality remote learning systems in place for Wednesday 6th January. The Blog (mightymugginton.wordpress.com) will form some part of this system but I am sure we can make improvements so home learning works as well as it can for you and your child(ren).

With this in mind, I would like to ask you to complete the following short questionnaire

Staff will be in school tomorrow to prepare for remote learning and to draw up a timetable to make sure there is capacity to look after children of critical key workers during the lockdown.

If you think you meet critical key worker criteria and will need your child to attend school between 9am and 3.15pm, please let me know the following information as quickly as possible:

- 1) Your critical key worker status
- 2) When you need your child to return to school
- 3) What days you need your child to be in school

Whilst children of critical key workers are in school there will be a minimum of two adults in the building, at least one of whom will hold Qualified Teacher Status.

An important caveat: the number of critical key worker children we can accommodate is limited because of staff numbers (the majority will work from home, in line with government guidelines, running the blog). However, please rest assured that we will do everything we can to support you during what will be a challenging six-week period.

Our staff and I are so sad that we will not be seeing your children back in school tomorrow. I cannot wait until we have Mighty Mugginton back as it should be.
